1	Soldiers of Conscience	86 minutes	To Kill or not to kill? For some, the war is within
2	Voices of Patriots	28 minutes	Interviews with four veterans (Marine Corporal to Air Force General) about the Iraq War.
3	Soldiers Speak Out	30 min segments; 3 hours total.	Documentary video, interviews and music
4	The Ground Truth	78 minutes	Outstanding video including gripping interviews with Iraq War veterans, a Marine recruiter and more. Excellent.
5	When I Came Home	70 minutes	Documentary about homeless vets in US. Explores challenges faced by returning combat veterans and the battle many must fight to receive VA benefits. Main character is a homeless Iraq War vet suffering from PTSD and living out of his car in Brooklyn. CAUTION: Includes strong street language.
6	Iraq for Sale	75 minutes	Uncovers the connections between private corporations making a killing in Iraq and the decision-makers who allow them to do so. Features Blackwater.
7	Arlington West	60 minutes	Documents the temporary cemetery in the sand erected every Sunday on southern California beaches by Veterans for Peace. Honors the fallen US soldiers. Includes interviews and video contrasting the enthusiasm of fresh recruits with veterans returning from combat.
8	Beyond Good and Evil	37 minutes	Examines how the rhetoric of good and evil has taught children to dehumanize the enemy, justify their killing and treat the suffering of innocent civilians as necessary sacrifice. Includes interviews with children, child psychologists and teachers.

9	War Made Easy (How Presidents and Pundits Keep Spinning Us to Death)	72 minutes	Documents a 50 year pattern of government deception and media spin that has dragged the US into one war after another from Vietnam to Iraq. Excellent archival footage of official distortion and exaggeration from LBJ to GW Bush. Narrated by Sean Penn.
10	A Soldier's Peace		Army journalist Marshall Thompson came home from tour of duty in Iraq and realized that the war is wrong and he needed to do something to stop it. He set off on foot to walk the entire 500-mile length of his conservative home state of Utah in the hopes of getting people talking about war and peace.
11	Why We Fight	98 minutes	Examines America's policies regarding making war, the "Bush doctrine" and pre-emptive attacks. Features interviews with representatives of the US military industrial complex and the prophetic warnings of former President Dwight D Eisenhower.
12	A Force More Powerful - Episode 1	approx 80 minutes	Historical footage and interviews telling about the use of non-violent civil disobedience to confront racial segregation in the US, British colonialism in India and apartheid in South Africa.
13	A Force More Powerful - Episode 2	approx 90 minutes	Historical footage and interviews documenting resistance in Denmark to Nazi Germany, in Poland and Chile against dictatorships.
14	Sir! No Sir!	85 minutes	The GI antiwar movement's tale of risk, defiance, and being forgotten by history, told through never-before-seen archival material and powerful interviews.
